PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

I hope this message, written and current as of **8/16/20**, finds you and your loved ones well and tranquil and that your practice is not only thriving but also growing. The future of our profession looks very secure, as the ADA News listed some of its recent key practice data findings, including the facts that 99% of dental practices had reopened as of the week of July 13, and that consumer polling indicates that 80% of adults are very comfortable visiting the dentist.

I personally feel this is because of the diligent efforts by each and every one of us to do our best in infection control, which we dentists learned well in our dental school training, and because the specialty of periodontics has played a most vital role in dentistry's being considered essential in disaster care management by both the ADA and the CDC. (Please see the SWSP website for recent AAP and ADA responses towards the WHO claim that all "elective" dental procedures should be postponed during the current pandemic.)

Because of both the AAP and the excellent periodontal research generated within our schools, we have been provided with exemplary scientifically-based literature to maximize public awareness that

oral care is necessary for overall systemic health. This gives even more reason to continue to donate to AAP projects and to support the AAP Foundation!

To be sure, this has been a very unusual year not only for everyone's practices, but in totality for our regional organization, as well. For example, those individuals involved with planning- and canceling- our summer meeting met multiple times in an effort to decide what action was best: to forge ahead in our hotel contract with optimistic caution- or to "call it" before we were irrevocably penalized.

Our history of allegiance to the venue enabled us to cancel the meeting without financial penalty, but rather was retooled to use the deposit over the next two years at the same hotel. Additionally, it was decided that a delay in the program until next summer will also allow everyone to enjoy an in-person speaker experience, rather than the lectures taking place virtually.

I feel compelled to add that with the very informal, but necessary, "changing of the guard" in officer and committee positions, the outgoing individuals did not get their due recognition for a year's worth of incessant travail. Dr. Richard Miron, DDS, MSc, PhD

Speaker Biography:

Dr. Richard Miron, DDS, MSc, PhD

University of Bern, Switzerland, Lead Educator Advanced PRF Education

Dr. Richard Miron is currently lead educator and researcher at Advanced PRF Education and an Adjunct Visiting Faculty in the department of Periodontology in Bern, Switzerland where he completed his PhD studies since 2009. He has currently published over 200 peer-reviewed articles and lectures internationally on many topics relating to growth factors, bone biomaterials and guided bone regeneration. For the past 3 years, Dr. Miron has been recognized by Dentistry Today as being one of the top 100 CE providers in the country and the youngest to ever make the list. He is also the top ranked researcher on Platelet-Rich Fibrin therapy as per Expertscape independent review. He has recently been awarded many recent international prizes in dentistry and is widely considered as one of the top contributors to implant dentistry having won the ITI Andre Schroeder Prize, the IADR Young Investigator of the Year in the field of Implant Dentistry as well as the IADR Socransky Research award in the field of Periodontology (2020). He has written 5 textbooks widely distributed in regenerative dentistry including his best-seller in 2019 titled: "Next Generation Biomaterials for Bone and Periodontal Regeneration."

SATURDAY PRESENTATION –In-Person and Virtual – Teaching Method: Lecture

Understanding Platelet Rich Fibrin

Presentation Abstract:

The use of platelet concentrates has had a long-history of use in various fields of medicine as an autologous source of growth factors fabricated utilizing centrifugation of blood under various conditions. While platelet rich plasma (PRP) was proposed as a first-generation platelet concentrate over 3 decades ago, over the past 10 years, platelet rich fibrin (PRF) has seen a steady increase in utilization for a variety of medical procedures due to its lack of anti-coagulation factors favoring fibrin clot formation and faster wound healing. More recently, the development of a liquid PRF provides a new formulation of liquid PRF without using anti-coagulation factors that may specifically be combined with currently available bone biomaterials favoring particle stability, angiogenesis

and tissue integration. This talk aims to highlight the recent advancements made with respect to the newest formulations of platelet concentrates including recent developments in horizontal centrifugation. Thereafter, the Bio-Heat technology will be presented with an ability to extend the working properties of PRF from 2-3 weeks to 4-6 months. Lastly, new clinical applications and uses of PRF will be presented in periodontology and facial esthetics.

Presentation Abstract:

This demonstration course will cover all the new advancements made with respect to the newest formulations of platelet concentrates. This will cover how to make custom-shaped PRF grafts, how to better concentrate liquid-PRF and will provide a better understanding for optimization of the protocols utilized in every day dental practice. Thereafter, the Bio-Heat technology will be presented. This will cover the heating steps necessary to extend the working properties of PRF from a fast-resorbing 2-3 week membrane towards a membrane that lasts 4-6

months. Various protocols will be demonstrated whereby clinicians will learn how to make an extended-PRF membrane that lasts 4-6 months, as well as how to make a novel sticky bone that contains an outer e-PRF membrane that may be utilized for ridge augmentation procedures.

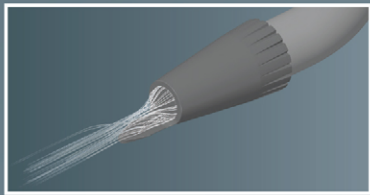

Membership Categories

\$175 Active Member (includes Academic and Active Duty Military Periodontists)

Limited to Periodontists, including Academic and Active Duty Military who are licensed to practice in the United States and who reside in the states of Arkansas, Colorado, Louisiana, Nebraska, Oklahoma or Texas, and who meet the qualifications for Active Member as listed in Article III of the By-laws of the Southwest Society of Periodontists.

\$175 Academic Non-Periodontist Member

Limited to individuals residing in the states of Arkansas, Colorado, Louisiana, Nebraska, Oklahoma or Texas, who do not meet the qualifications for Active membership, but who are engaged in full-time research and/or teaching in Periodontics in accredited dental schools at the undergraduate and/or graduate level. Has all of the privileges and responsibilities of Active Members except the rights to vote, to make nominations and to hold office. May serve on special committees.

\$0 Student Member

Student members do not pay annual dues and dues are waived for the first year after graduation from their training program.
